DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **2** Must the universe have a cause? If so, why doesn't God himself have a cause?
- ⁶ What's wrong with claiming that history has always (eternally) been growing, one day at a time, day after day?
- O So the universe must have a beginning. How compelling is this fact as evidence for God's existence?
- 6 How convincing do you find the Kalam cosmological argument?
